Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke: Glory to you, O Lord

Luke 22:1-16 NIV-UK

22 Now the Festival of Unleavened Bread, called the Passover, was approaching, ² and the chief priests and the teachers of the law were looking for some way to get rid of Jesus, for they were afraid of the people. ³ Then Satan entered Judas, called Iscariot, one of the Twelve. ⁴ And Judas went to the chief priests and the officers of the temple guard and discussed with them how he might betray Jesus. ⁵ They were delighted and agreed to give him money. ⁶ He consented, and watched for an opportunity to hand Jesus over to them when no crowd was present.

⁷ Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. ⁸ Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, 'Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover.'

Have you ever been aware of angels in your midst? Not many people have declared that to me, but I have met those who genuinely claim (with great reason) to be aware of their presence and comfort. Some have described feeling an arm round the shoulder, seeing a guard standing present by the altar, recognising the presence of angels waiting nearby, or near the sickbed of a loved one. I can feel them moving among us when I worship God in song and prayer sometimes. When the women arrived at the tomb on Easter morning, finding it empty. Instead of being left in a place of deep grief and uncertainty, God sent angels to comfort them and deliver the greatest news ever: He is not here: He has risen! How wonderful was that to hear the news from God? I think that we don't talk much about the heavenly realm at all - but this is for our loss, because angellos means messenger. To receive the heavenly realm means to be attuned to God's voice speaking to us through them. In the Eucharistic prayer we say as we take communion, there is a passage when we share together our response to a reminder of God's mighty acts - we call this the "Sanctus" where we join heaven's song, with angels and archangels and all the company of heaven: "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord, God of Power and might ..." There is a foretaste of heaven - to be surrounded by the heavenly hosts, worshipping the throne of Jesus for ever. What I hope is that we recognise the immense privilege of worship, and that it isn't for our benefit, but more that the attitude of our hearts is to worship God as we come to church, as we remember the Lord's sacrifice made once for all. Electoral Roll and GDPR

Every six years all members on the Church Electoral Roll will need to reapply for enrolment. The roll is a register of people who are eligible to take part in and vote at the annual meeting (APCM) and to be able to stand for various positions such as a members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC).
